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**Paul Freedman** is the author of numerous books, including *Images of the Medieval Peasant*, which garnered the Otto Grundler Prize from the International Congress of Medieval Studies and the Haskins Medal from the Medieval Academy of America. He has received numerous research awards, including fellowships from the Guggenheim

Foundation, the National Endowment for the Humanities, and the Center for Scholars and Writers at the New York Public Library. Prior to joining the faculty at Yale, Professor Freedman taught at Vanderbilt University, where he also served as director of the Robert Penn Warren Center for the Humanities from 1993 to 1997.
