Philo's Commentaries: *The Questions and Answers*. A "zetematic work" that uses questions and answers to work through the texts of Genesis 2:4-28:9 (*QG* 1-4) and Exodus 6:2-30:10 (*QE* 1-2).

The *Allegorical Commentary*, a series of consecutive treatises, emphasizes the allegory of the soul in the interpretation of Genesis 2:1-41:24 (*Alleg. Interpret.* 1-3, *Cherubim, Sacrifices, Worse, Posterity, Giants and Unchangeable, Agriculture, Planting, Drunkenness* 1-2 (one lost), *Sobriety, Confusion, Migration, Heir, Prelim. Studies, Flight, Names, Dreams* 1-5 (only 2-3 are extant)).

The *Exposition of the Law*. A thematic commentary on the law spans the entire Pentateuch (*Rewards* 1-3), more like rewritten Bible than a commentary proper (*Creation, Abraham, Joseph, Decalogue, Spec. Laws* 1-4, *Virtues, Rewards*).
