Melodores Singer Dies of Radioactive Poisoning

Tragedy struck campus on Sunday when university hospital officials announced that Melodores singer Neil McDaniels, who achieved campus popularity with his passionate rendition of "Radioactive" by Imagine Dragons, passed away from what the county coroner has confirmed to be acute radiation syndrome. 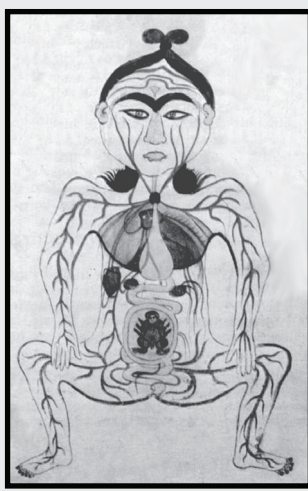

MoMA Adds Whiteboard Drawing of Penis to Collection

to its collection of pieces. Art critics have already heaped widespread praise on its artist, eleventh-grader Frank Pruitt.

"The choice of medium in and of itself is brave," explains *The Washington Post* columnist Paul Tridden. "Many of the most daring artists rethink just what goes on the canvas, but Pruitt rethinks the canvas itself."

The piece, entitled "Dick on a Whiteboard," joins current collections "American Modern: Hopper to O'Keeffe" and "Magritte, the Mystery of the Ordinary, 1926-1938" on exhibition in MoMA, renowned as one of the most influential museums in the world.

"As all great art does, this piece shocks," says Yale art history professor Dr. Yvette Turner. "The phallus is striking, and its curved shape and great size propel it to its status as a subject of important conversation, not to mention the stark, realistic depiction of pubic hair in a society increasingly obsessed with 'manscaping'."

With its staunch rebellion, Pruitt's expression stands strong against the current of today's increasingly uniform art culture, reminding us what good art should be. Its simplicity paradoxically makes it complex. The freedom of expression Pruitt has achieved in turn frees the viewer.

"This piece is a slap in the face of anyone who thought they knew what art was or could be," declares Dr. Turner.

Pruitt reports being satisfied with the piece's success. "I'm glad Mrs. Laskey finally submitted one of my dick drawings to that art contest," he says.

Pruitt's reaction has only garnered more favorable press from art experts. "This revolutionary expression of artistic genius is apparently representative of no more than this young man's norm. His extraordinary genius just might be definitive of his entire generation," Dr. Turner claims.

In response to his debut piece, numerous artistic institutions are vying for his membership. As of this printing, Pruitt has committed to none of these institutions.

The only known negative reaction to Pruitt's drawing comes from his own mother, who contends, "That can't really be necessary, now can it, Frankie?"



Pruitt's penis drawing has also been compared to many abstract expressionists including Rothko and de Kooning.

Toronto Mayor Won't Resign "Until you find the dark stuff"

Embattled Toronto Mayor Rob Ford spoke to the media earlier this week, facing public outrage over a recently surfaced video showing a drunk Ford smoking crack cocaine at a party. Ford has admitted that the video is authentic but says that he will not resign from his position "Until you guys [the media] find some of the really dark shit I've done."

No One Really Sure How to Raise Kids

In an alarming study, the Vanderbilt Institutional Research Group has recently declared that literally nobody really knows how to raise a kid, most notably their own. 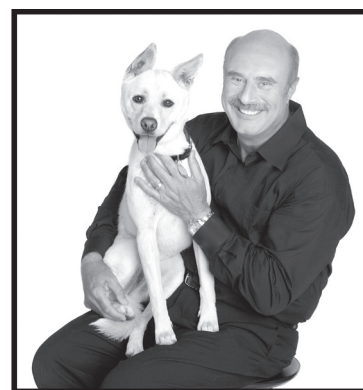

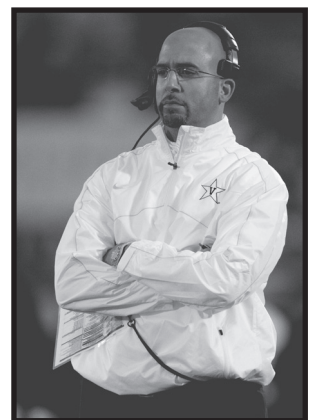

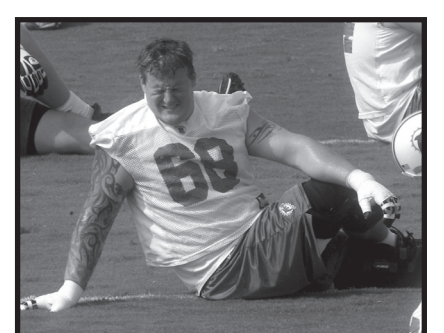

Jacksonville Jaguars Cure Suicidal Tendencies

The Jacksonville-based NFL team has recently discovered a new

way to salvage their 2013 season — not by their play on the field, but rather off it. Jacksonville psychiatrist Dr. Logan Buckner is now working with the team on a new curriculum to teach the police task units dispatched to try and prevent suicides that are unfolding, otherwise known as jumper squads. The technique? To teach the officers to convince those who would otherwise take their own life to keep living because there is no way their life could be worse than the Jacksonville Jaguars.

The idea came to Dr. Buckner, who suffers from manic depression, on the eve he was about to take his own life. "We have decades of emotional and psychological testing behind our curriculum as to how to connect with a complete stranger and comfort them. This new Jaguar-technique, though? It's like cheating. NCAA Adds Football Rule Against Committing Crimes

Citing the high number of crimes

frequently committed by college football players, the NCAA announced Sunday its plans to add a section in their official football rulebook penalizing players for violating university, state, and federal laws which are already in place. The regulation, referred to in the rulebook as "Transgressing," is the most major addition to the rulebook in recent years and seeks to cut back on the number of common crimes that players frequently commit including academic cheating, violations of alcohol and drug policies, and theft.

The new section, which is under Article XI in the rulebook and sits between rules outlining other infractions like clipping and delay of game, urges players to "not do things that are already illegal." The addition also clarifies that while all other football rules only apply during games, this rule should apply "all day every day according to the jurisdictions of the laws in question."

"College football players tend to be very disciplined on the field," said NCAA President Mark Emmert. "and we hope that this new rule will help our players to extend that same discipline to their actions off the field." NCAA Vice President Stephen

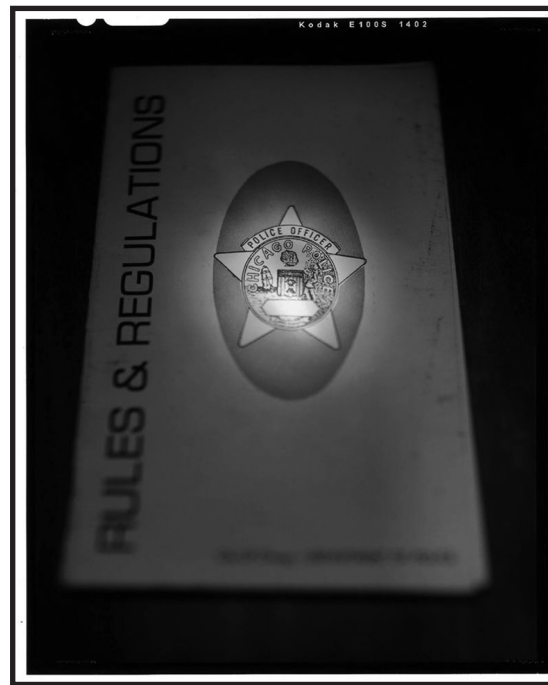
Crabe also noted in a press release that "In the past, the addition of rules has helped solve problems like rampant head and neck injuries, and we hope to see comparable reductions in the number of laws broken by players."

Violation of this new regulation will result in a loss of ten yards for the offending team and a replaying of the previous down, while felonies will result in a fifteen yard loss. Referees will announce the infraction during games by putting on a police hat and wagging a finger towards the offending player.

Many football players from across the country have spoken out in favor of the new rule. "It's nice to have these laws reiterated in terms we understand," said Stanford linebacker Isaiah Williams. "It totally makes sense now. Just because

we're really good at a sport doesn't mean we can ignore statutes."

The NCAA also plans to add the new rule to the rulebooks of all other sports in the near future. Initial reports show the rule has been wildly successful, and many players have shown unprecedented levels of restraint and upstanding behavior. Added Ohio State running back Tim McMillan: "I was going to commit rape the other day, but Coach Meyer has been talking to us recently about mental mistakes and carelessly losing yards, so I decided against it."

Homeless Man Excited to Witness Brief Flashes of Humanity During Holiday Season

NASHVILLE, TN- Area resident Paul Beckman told The

Slant that he eagerly awaits the beginning of the winter holidays as this is the time of year that "for brief moments here and there, people demonstrate the full empathy and compassion capable of human beings."

Beckman, a 54-year-old Tennessee native and former owner of a Waffle House franchise that went under during the recent recession, conceded that the winter months can be "unbearably cold" and "dangerous as hell," but noted that "for a couple of months, if you look closely, you can see that a few relatively decent people try to be better than they were before." Beckman

went on to explain that in the weeks leading up to Thanksgiving, "People have these transient moments of perspective when they just start to understand what the words 'I have a lot to be thankful for' actually mean."

Although the cold weather, coupled with limited beds in community shelters, can spell disaster for those living without stable housing, Beckman maintains that he still cherishes the months of November through January. "Some people complain about Christmas being over-commercialized, but I just like to closely watch people for their moments of generosity."

"Maybe someone will donate a little bit of money to charity when they normally don't even realize the underprivileged exist, or a woman will take her kids to see their grandparents even though she's been on bad terms with them for years," Beckman explained to The Slant. "And if you're cynical, you'll point at that and say 'well they feel obligated to do those things,' but if you ask me, I think it's a sign that there's still something human in all of us."

Beckman, who lacks the practical resources necessary to successfully complete a job search due to his difficulty finding stable housing, claims that the holidays are his favorite time of year. "New Year's is very warming too," he told The Slant. "Because if you pay attention to what people are saying, if you're lucky, you'll notice that they believe in second chances and fresh starts."

one here like me. I know what you're thinking, and you're right. I'm... pregnant.

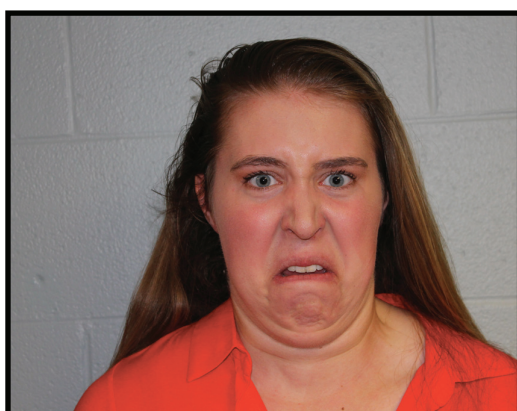

Braised Paula Deen Shoulder with Red Wine Sauce

Ingredients:

- 20 lbs. Deen shoulder
- 4 Carrots, peeled, chopped
- 4 shallots, chopped
- 2 stalks celery, chopped
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 cup red wine
- 2 gallons Deen stock
- 1 tbsp. tomato puree
- 4 tbsp. salted butter
- 1 stalk fresh thyme
- 3 stalks fresh parsley

Butchering the Carcass:

1) Gut the Deen so it can be stored later. Start by finding the top of the abdominal cavity by feeling down her rib cage along the sternum. Where the sternum ends, begin cutting down the length of her belly until you reach the pubic bone, and remove the viscera, making sure to keep her liver and intestines intact. (These will make a fantastic pate and sausage respectively.) Reach up into the thoracic cavity and remove her heart and lungs. These can be cast aside.

2) With a butcher knife, remove her head, making sure to wipe off the excess of make-up on her face. Set into a pot for later, as we will use this to make a Deen stock.

3) Find the trapezius and deltoid muscles and detach them from the Deen's bones. The rest of the carcass can be stored for later use.

Tip:

It is important to set up your mise en place BEFORE beginning to cook so ingredients are organized and easily accessible.

Preparing the Deen:

1) Season the Deen shoulder with salt and pepper. In a hot pot on high heat, drizzle about 1 tbsp. of a neutral oil. We don't like using olive oil here, as its flavor is a bit too strong for our taste. As the oil is being heated, add the butter. The butter will add a lovely color and flavor to the meat. But be careful – butter burns easily!

2) Just before the oil/butter begins smoking, add the Deen shoulder. Do not stir the Deen shoulder quite yet, as doing so will reduce the heat in the pan. As it cooks, it caramelizes beautifully, giving the dish a nice, rich flavor and color. Brown the shoulder on all sides and remove from the pan.

3) Add about another tablespoon of oil into the pan and turn the heat down to medium. Add the shallots, celery, carrots, and garlic. Sweat the vegetables for about one minute and add the tomato puree.

4) Add the red wine to the pot, scraping at the bottom of the pot with your wooden spoon to incorporate all that lovely flavor into the red wine sauce. We want to reduce the red wine sauce at a nice, gentle simmer.

5) Once the red wine has reduced slightly, add the Deen stock. We make fresh Deen stock by simmering Deen's head with celery, onions, and carrots in water for one hour. The Deen stock is full of flavor, but it needs a little help with seasoning – season with salt and pepper after adding the Deen stock, and remember: always taste and adjust! Remove the thyme leaves from the stem and add the leaves to the pot.

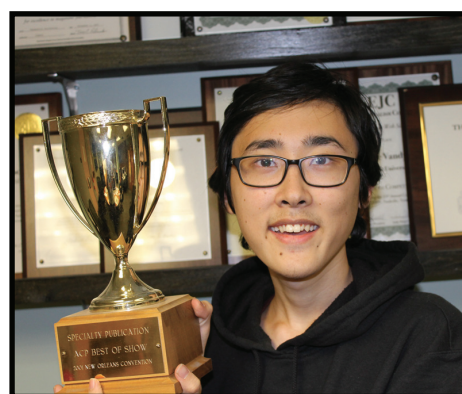
6) Once the stock has come to a boil, add the Deen shoulder back into the pot, making sure the level of liquid is just covering the meat and vegetables. Reduce the heat to low and put on the lid. Let simmer for 2-3 hours.

7) Take the pot off the heat, top with chopped parsley, and voilà: A delicious shoulder of Paula Deen with a red wine sauce. Best served hot over a bed of rice. Bon Appétit!

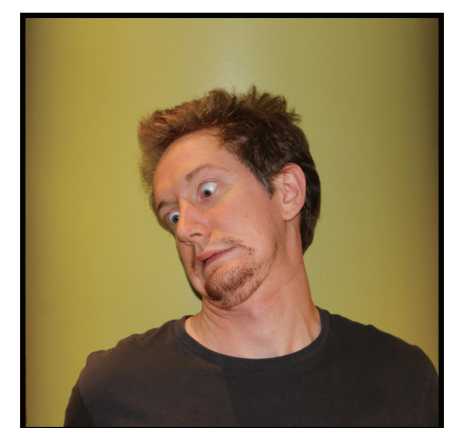

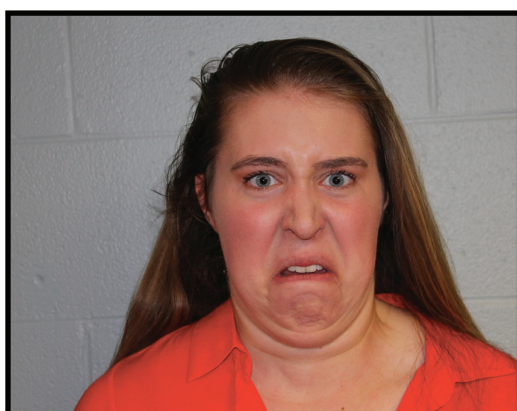
